Style – Meddling with our original SuperCollider DIPA (circa 2011), the Flying Monkeys brewed a revisionary 2.0 gaining insight into the limitless flavours of the DIPA. Clocking in at 102 IBUs with a steady burn of 10.4% alc./vol., SuperCollider 2.0 DIPA is scientific evidence –the beer universe is expanding.

Taste – With an opening salvo of intense citrus and grapefruit aromas followed by the tropical, spicy and earthy undertones, this Double India Pale Ale is a bold and spacious brew. Deep gold with citrine lights, the complex flavors orbit around a smooth yet pronounced caramel malt center within a swirling, effervescent vortex of hops –Columbus, Amarillo, Summit, and the super-blend, Falconer's Flight.

Serve With – Double IPAs are perfect alone. But if you've got a hankering, pair strong beers with strong flavours. Double IPAs work well with flavourful foods like salty ham, saucy ribs, and strong cheese like Stilton or Gruyere.

Drinkers – For the craft beer curious and Specialty enthusiasts. Brewed for adventurous patrons desiring a unique Ontario beer experience.

ABV – 10.4%

OG – 1.095 SG

SRM – 7.7

Malts – Pale Malt, and Victory Malt

Boil Hops – Columbus, Amarillo Gold, Falconer's Flight

Late Addition Hops – Summit, Falconer's Flight 7Cs
